ANDERS AND THE FLAME BEARER READING SCAVENGER HUNT

This reading scavenger hunt is a really fun way to enhance your reader's experience. It takes a little work to put together, but this package will get you started.

Here's how the hunt works:

First, you are going to purchase the items on the shopping list attached to this packet.

Next, group together each gift with the corresponding note as outlined on the next page. You are going to wrap each item, but make sure the note is included INSIDE the wrapped package.

Next, wrap each of the items (with the corresponding note inside the wrapped package). Note that the Toblerone and the Gummy Slider will be grouped together as 1 item.

Next, on each gift, attach a label that identifies which chapter the gift corresponds to (I used a label maker and simply said "Chapter 1" etc.). Also, cut out the picture-clue that corresponds with that chapter and tape it to the gift. The picture clues are included with this packet.

Finally, deliver the wrapped items to your reader together with the introductory note on page 4 of the packet. Make sure your reader reads the introductory note before they start and certainly before they open any of the wrapped packages!

- Clue: blue flame

- Note:

Light it in a quiet room and get ready to summon your inner hobbit. Every time the wick starts to crackle, it feels like you're in front of a cozy fireplace with warm woolly socks on your feet. Enjoy snuggling up to this one while you read Anders and the Flame Bearer.

Chapter 6:

- Gift: Gummy Worms

- Clue: Pile of dirt

Chapter 10:

- Gift: 1 Toblerone and 1 Gummy Slider

- Clue: Slide

- Note:

A chocolate mountain and a sweet slide(r) (See what I did there?)

- Alternative Note:

A sweet mountain peak and a bunch of ice. All you're missing is the slide.

Chapter 14:

- Gift: Small stuffed animal

- Clue: Hamster

- Note:

Oddly enough, I couldn't find a store that carries plush mumpkins. But if you hold this out and squint a little, the resemblance is remarkable.

Chapter 17:

- Gift: Scandinavian Swimmers from Trader Joe's or Swedish Fish

- Clue: Swimmer

- Note:

Astrid might be the best Scandinavian Swimmer in the book – much more stealth than any of the Swedish Fish in the ocean.

Chapter 22:

Gift: Journal

- Clue: Scroll

- Note:

There is a lot of power in gratitude. Anders' dad encouraged the Klausen to harness that power by reflecting on the gifts that meant the most to them at the end of each year. Whether you want to reflect on the gifts that have meant the most to you this year, like the Klausen do, keep a gratitude journal, or have a different idea, I hope you'll use this journal for something that is meaningful and uplifting to you.
